

LAWYERS CONDEMN LYNCHING.

Bar Association Pronounces It "a Willful and Deliberate Murder."

SALT LAKE CITY, Aug. 19.—A resolution on the Leo M. Frank lynching, presented to the American Bar Association today by Stephen S. Gregory of Illinois, was adopted unanimously. It pronounced the lynching "a willful and deliberate murder by mob violence, concerted and accomplished in a spirit of savage and remorseless cruelty unworthy of our age and time."

It expressed the hope of the association that the authorities will speedily punish the guilty parties.
